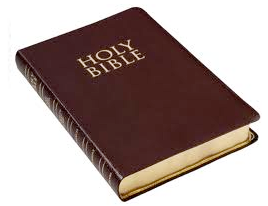




Time 4 Truth

Monday

"Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,"
(Hebrews 12:1, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

The plan God has for you is less tiring and troubling when you choose to lay aside sin.

Living the Truth:

Tuesday

Learning the Truth:

Living the Truth:

In the times you are tempted today, stop and ask God to show you the way out of it, trust Him.

Thursday

(Matthew 26:41, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Avoiding temptation requires vigilance and prayer. Rely upon strength from God and not yourself.

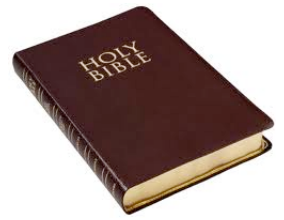
Living the Truth:

Saturday

(1 John 1:9, NKJV)*

Meaning of Truth:

Jesus faithfully forgives when you humbly confess.

Living the Truth:

Get real with Jesus and admit your sins to Him.
Ask for forgiveness and be willing to accept it.
Enjoy the cleanliness and rightness Jesus gives.
