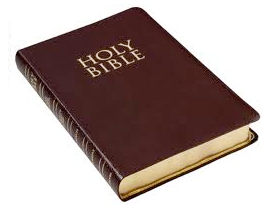




Time 4 Truth

Monday

“For we walk by faith, not by sight.”
(2 Corinthians 5:7, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Following Jesus means trusting His vision and not yours.

Living the Truth:

Trust to live for Jesus this week because only He can see what it holds for you.

Tuesday

*“I have been crucified with Christ;
it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me;
and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in
the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”*
(Galatians 2:20, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

To live for Christ means one must die to self and faithfully live trusting Jesus.

Living the Truth:

Pray asking what must leave your life so you can truly live for Jesus. Trust Him enough to fully follow.

Wednesday

*“hearing of your love and faith which you have toward
the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints,”*
(Philemon 5, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Philemon had a reputation of love and faith towards God and other believers.

Living the Truth:

Ask God to create through you a reputation of loving faithfulness to God and all those at Oak Hill Baptist. Pray that as a church we would be known for our love of God and all people.

Thursday

*“For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach,
because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all
men, especially of those who believe.”*
(1 Timothy 4:10, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Trusting God means working hard at godliness in spite of suffering.

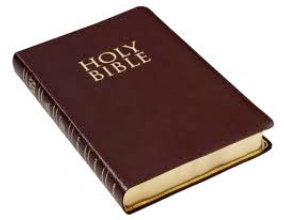
Living the Truth:

Friday

*"If we are faithless,
He remains faithful;
He cannot deny Himself."
(2 Timothy 2:13, NKJV)*

Meaning of Truth:

God is always faithful, even when we are not.

Living the Truth:

Trust the faithfulness of God.
Be faithful for He is faithful.

Saturday

*"And the apostles said to the Lord,
"Increase our faith."
(Luke 17:5, NKJV)*

Meaning of Truth:

The apostles asked Jesus to give them more faith.

Living the Truth:

"Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God." (Romans 10:17). Increasing faith requires getting in God's Word and letting it get in you.
