


Time 4 Truth

Monday

"Jesus said to him, You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." (Matthew 22:37, NKJV)

"I will praise You, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works." (Psalm 9:1, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

The top priority in life is to completely love God.

Living the Truth:

Surrender all of your loves for loving God first.

Wednesday

(James 5:13, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Tuesday

Living the Truth:

Thursday

"I will sing of the mercies of the LORD forever; With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness to all generations." (Psalm 89:1, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Be ever-ready to tell others of God's faithfulness.

Living the Truth:

Tell someone younger than you how God has shown you His faithfulness throughout the years.

Friday

As you lay in bed tonight thank God for all His goodness until you fall asleep.

Saturday

"saying with a loud voice:
"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain
To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength
and honor and glory and blessing!""

(Revelation 5:12, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Jesus is worthy of honor because He is Savior!

Living the Truth:

Come tomorrow ready to praise with a loud voice the reigning King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
