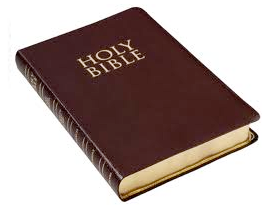




Time 4 Truth

Week of March 30, 2014



Monday

*“And this is eternal life,
that they may know You, the only true God,
and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.”*

(John 17:3, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Eternal life is the present reality of knowing God and Jesus, not something only in the future.

Living the Truth:

If you are a follower of Jesus, then enjoy eternal life today knowing Jesus is with you. If you are not a follower of Jesus, then surrender your life to faithfully follow Him and enjoy real eternal life.

Tuesday

*“Now I am no longer in the world,
but these are in the world, and I come to You.
Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You
have given Me, that they may be one as We are.”*

(John 17:11, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Jesus asked the Father to protect/keep the unity between His followers in the world.

Living the Truth:

Pray today that God would allow this church family to be as unified as Jesus is with the Father. Next pray that this unity would be experienced with one another and with God.

Wednesday

*“But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the
world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.”*

(John 17:13, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Jesus prayed that His followers would live in this world with His divine joy fulfilled in their life.

Living the Truth:

Are you living with a joy-filled life?
Pray and ask now that God would grant you a joy for life and worship of Him.

Thursday

*“They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. As You
sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the
world.”* (John 17:16-18, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Jesus prayed that His followers be made different by God's word so they could be a witness in this world.

Living the Truth:

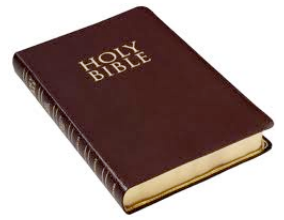
The only way to live differently than this world is to ask God to give you a greater passion for His word. Read John 17 and ask God to speak to you.

Friday

“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.”

(John 17:20–21, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Jesus prayed for the future believers who would believe because of the witness of His followers. His prayer was that they would be unified with one another and Them so others would also believe.

Living the Truth:

Pray today for someone who needs to know the Lord. Pray that they would see God by the lifestyles of believers. Ask God to use you to tell someone of what He has done in your life.

Saturday

“And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.”

(John 17:22-23, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Jesus gives His believers divine glory. He also prays again that they/we would be as unified and singularly focused upon God and His desire for everyone to truly know His love through Jesus.

Living the Truth:

Simply pray that God would allow you to experience His glorious love. Then ask your heavenly Father to help you see, live, and love this world as He loves it. Love God and this world enough to bring someone with you tomorrow as we worship God together.
