Monday

"If we confess our sins,

(1 John 1:9, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Forgiveness is granted to those who agree with God about the things in their life that are sin.

Living the Truth:

Humbly ask God to search your life for anything that does not please Him. Agree with Him and ask for forgiveness. Look at His promise in the verse above.

Tuesday

"For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus," (1 Timothy 2:5, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Only Jesus can bring together God and man.

Living the Truth:

Admit your helplessness in coming to God on your own. Speak to Jesus of your great need for Him.

Wednesday

Living the Truth:

Thursday

Learning the Truth:

God completely separates you from the penalty and power of any and all sin!

Living the Truth:

Ask for then accept God's total forgiveness. Be ready to forgive others in the same way.
