Jericho was next.

Great works are easy for God!

Obediently trusting God with the future should become easier as we remember the great works we have seen Him do in our past.

(Remember) the great works God has done.

"What have you seen God do?

God is personal and powerful in the life of His people. (23)

God stopped a river that was flowing over its banks

God then made the riverbed dry.

God released the river's water after they reached the other side.

God is faithful and never fails.

Israelites were following God and God's man.

(Remember) God's personal demonstration of power in your life. "What has God done in your life?"

God is purposeful in the life of His people. (24)

That all the peoples of the earth may now the hand of the LORD

That it is mighty

That you may fear the LORD your God forever

(Remember) to honor God with all your life. "What are you living life for?"
