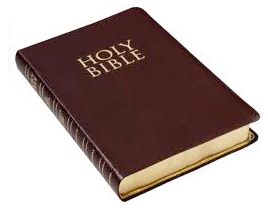




Time 4 Truth

Monday

"Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!"
(Psalm 100:1, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

All people are to raise their voices in praise.

Living the Truth:

Find somewhere and pray out loud to God today.

Tuesday

*"Serve the LORD with gladness;
Come before His presence with singing."*
(Psalm 100:2, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Serving God should gladly be done.

Living the Truth:

Will you look forward to living for Jesus today?

Wednesday

*"Know that the LORD, He is God;
It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves;
We are His people and the sheep of His pasture."*
(Psalm 100:3, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

God is God and we are not!

Living the Truth:

Ask God what He has created you to do, then gladly live your life doing just that!

Thursday

*"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving,
And into His courts with praise.
Be thankful to Him, and bless His name."*
(Psalm 100:4, NKJV)

Learning the Truth:

Giving God thanks is preparation for worship.

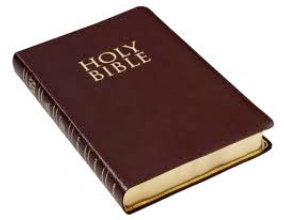
Living the Truth:

Friday

*“For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting,
And His truth endures to all generations.”*

(Psalm 100:5, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Joyful service originates with experiencing God’s goodness, His mercy, and His truth.

Living the Truth:

If God is good, merciful, and truthful wouldn’t you want to gladly live for Him in all aspects of life?
(He will never badly, harshly, or deceitfully lead you!)

Saturday

*“But as for you, brethren,
do not grow weary in doing good.”*

(2 Thessalonians 3:13, NKJV)

Meaning of Truth:

Do not grow tired in doing that which is good.

Living the Truth:

Grow tired of doing that which is not God’s good plan. If we let anything keep us from doing what is godly, then we would miss God’s goodness in life. CHOOSE THE GODLY!!
