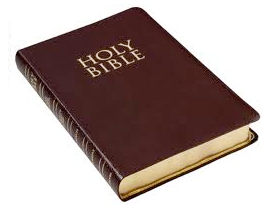




Time 4 Truth

Living the Truth:

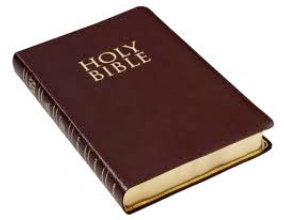
Sincerely pray today asking God to direct your next step in life. Daily steps following the Lord turn into long journeys of experiencing God's faithfulness.
