I. Marriage

- A. Should Point Others to the Cross. vv. 18-19
 - 1. Ephesians 5:22-24
 - 2. Ephesians 5:33
 - 3. Matthew 22:30

If Christ is not Lord of all, He is not Lord at all! Romans 5:8

B. GOALS FOR OUR MARRIAGE

- 1. Pray together every night. (1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- 2. Read Scripture together every day. (Psalm119:20,97,105; Joshua 1:8; 2 Timothy 2:15)
- 3. Constantly work to put each other first. (Philippians 2:3-5)
- 4. "Our Time" at least once a week. (Ecclesiastes 9:9)
- 5. "<u>Talk Time</u>" Listen to each other; show genuine interest and concern in each other's activities, responsibilities, and burdens. (**Galatians 6:2**)
- 6. Never leave or go to bed <u>angry</u> at each other; take all <u>disagreements</u> to the Lord. (**Ephesians 4:26,27**)
- 7. Stay true to your <u>vows</u> to each other (**Ecclesiastes 5:5; Proverbs 2:16,17**). Remember, true love lasts. (1 Corinthians 13:8) If for some reason you break a vow, you must confess, repent, and humble yourself. (**James 5:16**)
- 8. Be <u>forgiving</u> of each other by never bringing up wrongs committed in the past, dwelling on them in your own mind, or discussing them with others. (**Psalm 103:12; Colossians 3:13**)
- 9. Don't allow yourselves to be put in <u>compromising</u> situations. Have character (be the same away from one another's presence as we would in one another's presence). (I Corinthians 6:18-20; 1Thessalonians 5:22)
- 10. Never tear <u>down</u>; always <u>build</u> up. (**Ephesians 4:29**) Communicate consistently, clearly, cautiously, and caringly with each other. (**James 1:19**; **Ephesians 4:32**)

Marriage is a <u>beautiful</u> <u>picture</u> of God's love for us. He gave His life for the <u>bride</u>, the <u>church</u>!
